*The Assistant* is the story of Frank Alpine - a man with a troubled past, who comes to work as a helper to a Jewish couple and their attractive daughter, who operate a failing grocery store in a declining Brooklyn neighborhood. His struggles between the forces of his past and the urge to do the right thing make fascinating reading.
