Although the championship trophy was just out of reach, the Charlotte team did win the consolation bracket with a dramatic "come from behind" overtime victory against a tough Richmond team.

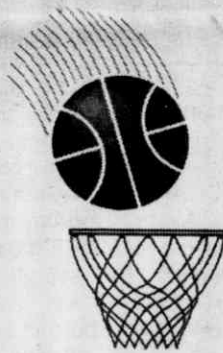
Scott Hirsch's 3 pointer sent the game into overtime and Keith Kaplan's crucial free throws in overtime sealed the victory.

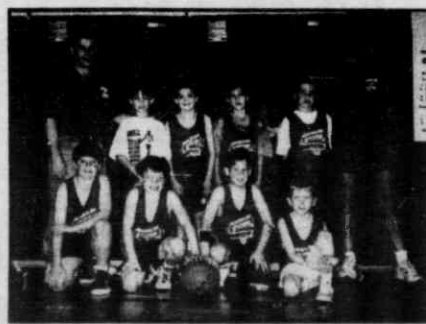

AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD TRAINING
