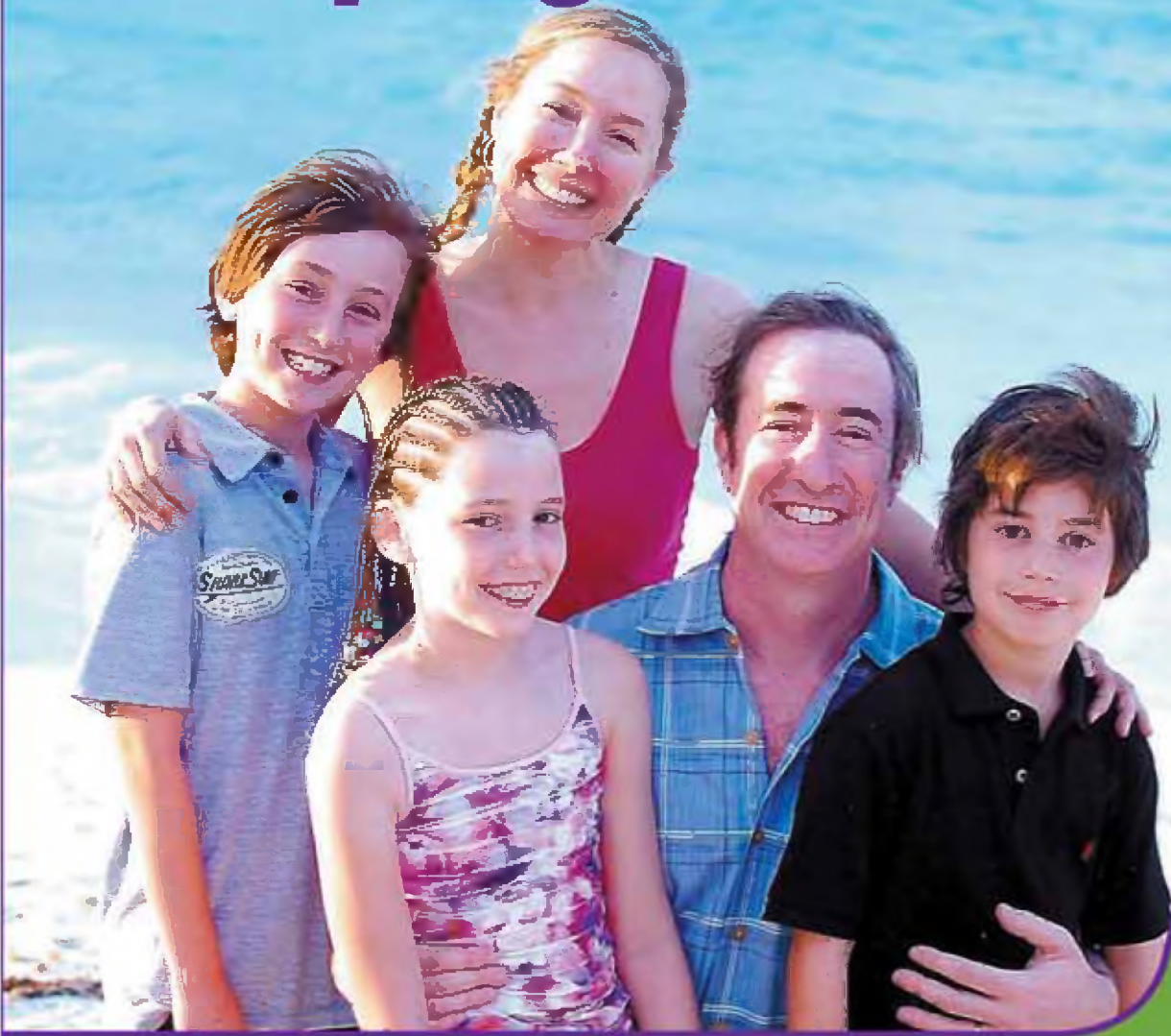


Shaping the J since 1994.
