"World View" is based on CNN's program, "Anderson Cooper's 360°." The stage show takes the format of a 45-minute lecture followed by a 45-minute Q&A session.

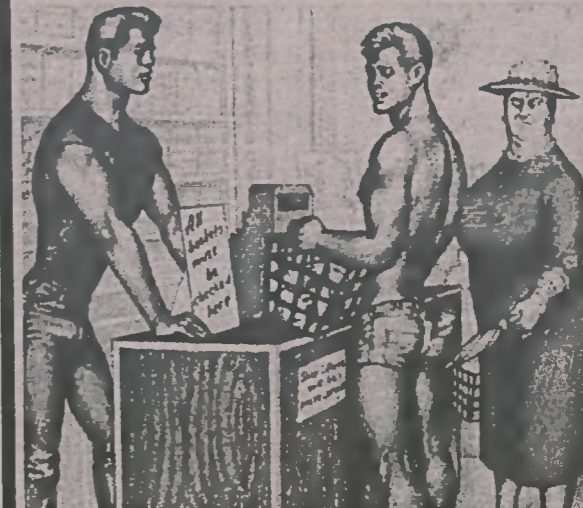
