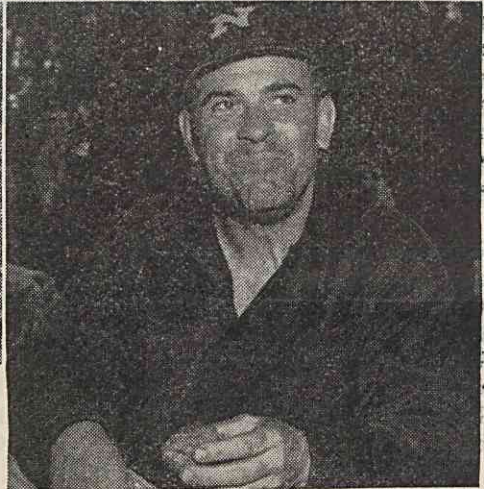
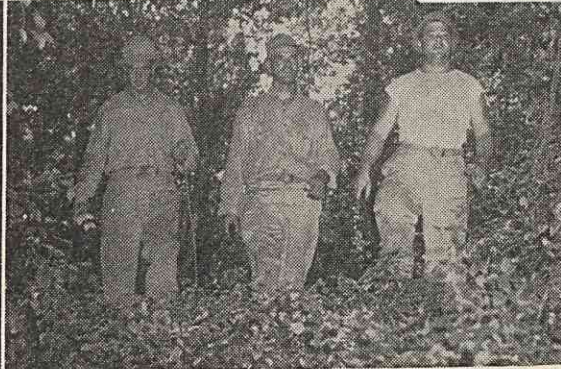
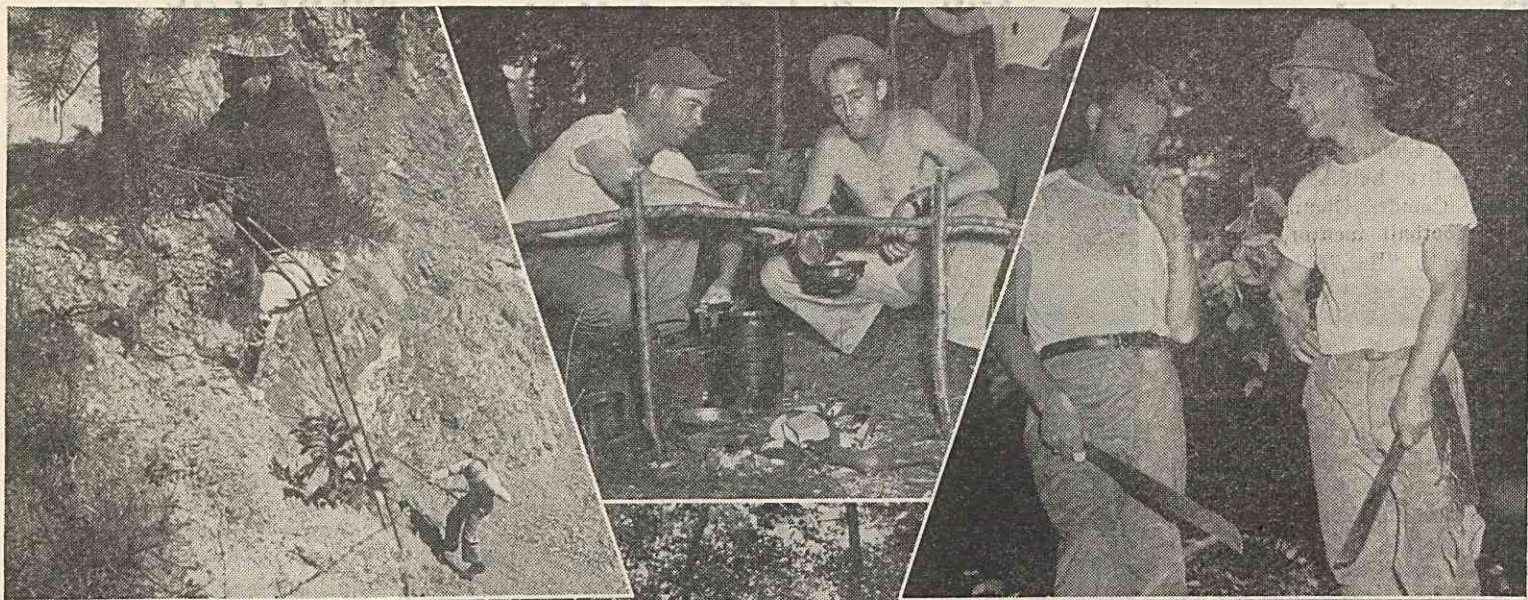


Camera Captures Varied Views of Survival School

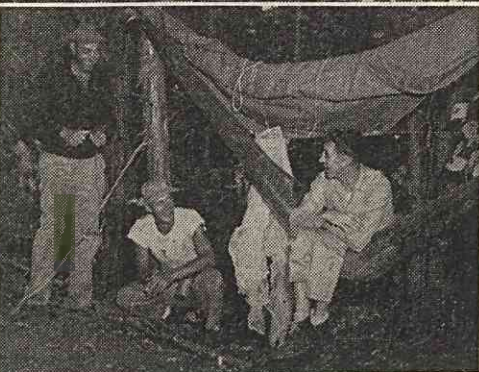
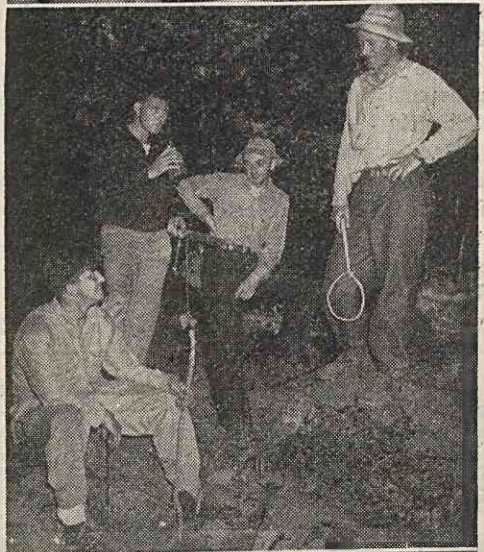
