

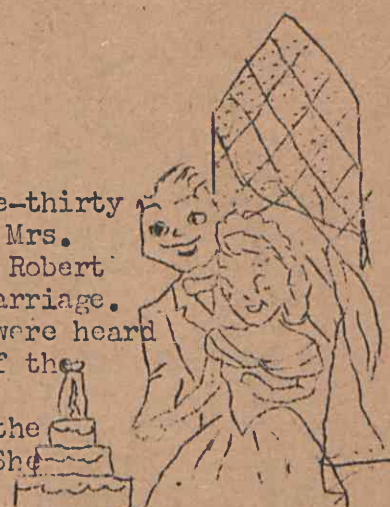
WEDDING BELLS
