They were there and even some remember! Here is where we drag out the old skeleton from the closet and expose some to you with photos of years ago and a few recent snapshots:



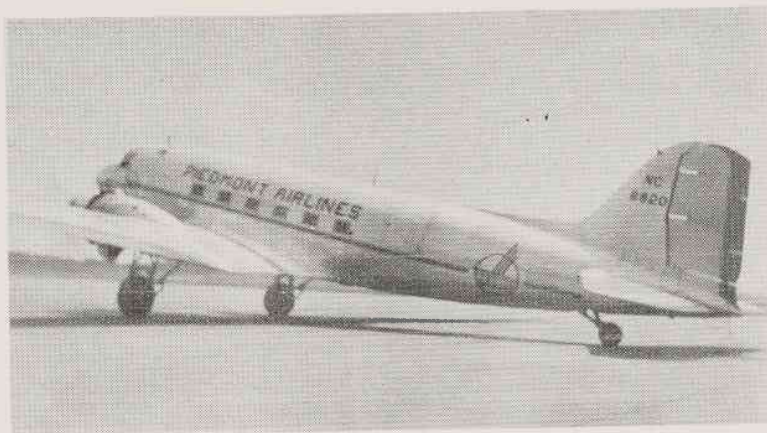

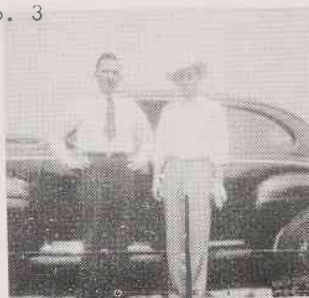

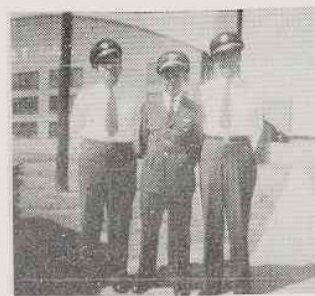

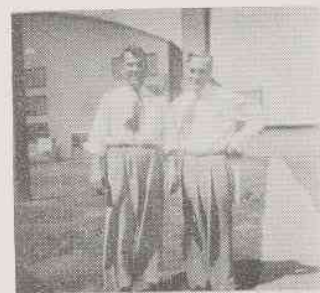
