CAB TO START HEARINGS ON LOCAL AIR SERVICE

The Civil Aeronautics Board will begin hearings May 4 in the Piedmont Area local service case which includes an application by Piedmont Airlines for extended north and south service.

The opening date of the hearings was announced recently in a CAB order consolidating all applications and fixing boundaries for the investigation.

The Piedmont request asks for CAB authority to serve an additional 21 cities including Baltimore, Atlanta, Augusta, Florence, S. C., Rocky Mount, Jacksonville, Elizabeth City, Goldsboro and Staunton, Va. It would add more than 5,000 miles to the airline system.
