Tests Helped

The results of Pre-Vocational tests pointed unmistakably in the direction of printing as an occupation in which Henry was interested and would probably do well. His visual handicap was an obstacle for this type work and yet all other signs and clues pointed in this direction.

After a six months training period Henry graduated last January. Several job opportunities were explored but three months went by before a lead paid off. In April a local firm hired Henry and he is working there now, a well-adjusted wage earner and another success story in the rehabilitation effort.

Henry and little Susan represent only two case histories out of thousands helped by the United Fund each year. In addition, normal life is made more interesting and productive through organizations such as the YMCA and YWCA, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Community cultural centers.
