Two new items are now available in the Carelines' employee catalog from Piedmont's Purchasing Department.

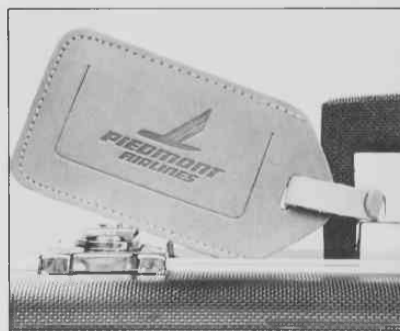
