"The \$25,000 Pyramid" isn't the first game show on which Sullivan has appeared. Last year, she won prizes



worth \$250 on "Sale of the Century," and eight years ago, she appeared with her husband's family on "Family Feud" on which they won over \$5,000 in addition to an all-expense-paid vacation to California for the show.

"It was exciting," Sullivan added, "a real dream come true."
