Questions

1. Which airline was the first to join The Piedmont Commuter System and when did the joint program begin?
2. When did Piedmont inaugurate service to Denver, CO (DEN)?
3. Approximately how many meals and snacks did Piedmont serve in 1986?
4. What company staffs our "check-in" counter at Gatwick Airport?
5. How many reservations centers does Piedmont have and where are they located?

Answers to questions in August Piedmonitor

1. Piedmont's reservations centers answered a total of 3,125,199 calls in June 1987, the first month calls exceeded three million.
2. By the end of 1987, Piedmont will have 181 aircraft in the fleet, including four 767-200s, 62 737-200s, 36 737-300s, 25 F28-4000s, 20 F28-1000s, and 34 727-200s.
3. So far this year, Piedmont Airlines has added service to Seattle (May 15), London (June 15), and Birmingham and Columbus (both September 10). On October 18, Indianapolis will join the system, on November 15, Nassau, and on December 8, Phoenix and San Diego.
4. Piedmont, in conjunction with Funway Holidays, opened a travel store in Orlando last December to sell complete travel packages called Piedmont Vacations. These packages include round-trip air transportation, a rental car, hotel accommodations, and tickets to local attractions.
5. Piedmont's slogan this year is "Piedmont. A model of how good an airline can be."
