Dixie Hall is one of the oldest houses in Macon County. The kitchen and slave quarters were built in the 1830's. Ten rooms were added in 1860. The two-story porches with Ionic columns and Gothic-arched lattices are a distinctive feature that was rare in architecture even "Before the War".

The house narrowly escaped destruction by Federal troops in 1865. During all the years since then it has been loved and lived in by succeeding generations who have declined to "modernize" its quiet charm. Dixie Hall has been owned only by descendants of its pioneer builders. Evelyn Hope Daniels is a member of that family.

Today this ante bellum residence is playing a dual role. First it is a remainder of the beauty and dignity of old-time Southern life. And second, by serving as a center for the latest trends in decoration, Dixie Hall keeps pace with the present.
