### A 75th ANNIVERSARY

In June, 1884, when the village of Highlands was only nine years old, its leading citizens met to elect the first officers and trustees of the Hudson Library Association. The purpose of this organization was to support, and to conduct the affairs of the Hudson Library, then in its infancy. Today, three-quarters of a century later, this organization, now known as the Hudson Library of Highlands, North Carolina, Incorporated, is still very much alive.

The officers elected at that early meeting were: S.T. Kelsey, founder of Highlands, president; J. Baxter White, the town's first postmaster, vice-president; G.F. Wheeler, secretary; W.C. Trowbridge, treasurer. The trustees, or
