Her portraits in bas-relief mounted on velvet and set in specially made frames are family treasures.

Miss McLean has won National recognition for her work in clay. She is a former scholarship award winner to the Corcoran School of Art in Washington, D.C.; the Art Students' League in New York City, the Dept. of Sculpture at Columbia University, and until 1949 was at the Yale School of Fine Arts. Her work is on display at the Florida Gulf Coast Art Center where she is a member of the staff. Miss McLean received National recognition for her collection of thirty-three miniature and exact replicas of America's First Ladies in their inaugural gowns.

From June to November her work will be displayed at Clover Hill Surprise Shop. Appointments may be made for special order work and Miss McLean will be glad to discuss her ceramics, sculptures, and oils with anyone interested.

During the winter months, Ethel McLean's studio is at the entrance to Belleair, Clearwater, Florida, where ahe has been since 1950.
