The incoming Secretary and Treasurer, Mr. Dan McCall and Mr. Richard Harrison, gave a brief report presenting general information pertaining to the work of their office.

Mr. Ellison Magruder presented the question "What can our Club of 16 members do to serve others in the coming year?" The final plea of the incoming President to the regular members was that they give one hour per week so that Rotary can go forward even more towards "Service Above Self"——helping others by giving of "self" for the community and future. Mr. Magruder concluded by saying, "This is Rotary——even a small club can be a lot of Rotary——and we have!"
