THE COMANCHEROS

In bringing to the CinemaScope screen Paul I. Wellman's successful novel of Tex-
as Rangers, Comanche uprisings and a ruth-
less renegade band terrorizing settlers in
1840, 20th Century-Fox has come up with an
action-packed drama, "The Comancheros,"
starring John Wayne, Stuart Whitman, Ina
Balin, Nehemiah Persoff and Lee Marvin.
The DuLuxe color production opens Thur-Fri,
June 28-29 at the GALAX THEATRE.

Wayne plays Ranger Captain Jake Cutter
assigned to penetrate the ranks of an out-
law band, the "Comancheros" who are supply-
ing the Indians with guns and whiskey and
have caused the slaughter of many settlers.
Opposing his plan to turn the renegade mem-
bers against one another is gambler-gunner
Whitman, sadistic gang leader Persoff, his
daughter and Whitman's sweetheart, Ina Ba-
lin, and gun-runner Lee Marvin. Support-
ing this quartet of antagonists are the
fierce Comanches under the influence of
the "paleface's firewater," eager to kill
innocent women and children.

The George Sherman production, filmed
on location in Moab, Utah, boasts a fine
cast of supporting players that include
Michael Ansara, Bruce Cabot, Pat Wayne,
Joan O'Brien, "Big Boy" Williams, and
Edgar Buchanan.
