WHITESIDE MOUNTAIN—UNAKA-KANCOOS

The following passage is from Judge Felix Alley's book, "Random Thoughts and the Musings of a Mountaineer." Judge Felix was born and reared in Western North Carolina....

"A few days ago I went back to the old

home and scenes of my childhood, at the base of Whiteside Mountain, in the southern part of Jackson County, where my parents lived together for fifty-nine years, and where their ten children were born and reared.

"I went first to the top of Whiteside, which rises five thousand four hundred feet above sea level, and stood upon the rugged cliffs and crags forming that towering mountain, subdued and toned in their gigantic grandeur by the blue haze that is
