MIRROR LAKE DAM IS OUT

An abrupt change has taken place in the lovely Mirror Lake section--that being that the lake is gone! The dam, having been in poor condition for some time, has broken, and all the water, except a tiny trickle, has vanished.

This situation is bad, not only because summer and local residents, and tourists miss the lake for its beauty and recreation, but also because the Lake provides a big tourist attraction during the winter with its ice-skating.

It is hoped that the dam can be completely re-built within the next year. Plans were initiated by Mr. Clyde Bolt, Sr. and Mr. H. E. Glenn for a survey and estimate to determine the cost of a new dam. Some of those living in the Lake area have contributed toward this project, and thus a fund has been started. Others interested are invited to share in the expense of restoring the scenic Mirror Lake.
