\$2,302 MADE AT HOSPITAL BAZAAR

One of the primary lookout points for the U. S. Forest Service in this vicinity is Yellow Mountain. With an elevation of 5,127 feet, the Mountain commands one of the most spectacular views found anywhere in this immediate area. The piedmont section of South Carolina, parts of Georgia, the Balsam and Nantahala Mountains, and north into the Smokies of North Carolina are viewed from the scenic top. TRUSTEE OF BIOLOGICAL STATION DROWNS

Dr. Royal E. Shanks, professor of botany, University of Tennessee, and distinguished member of the Board of Trustees of the Biological Station, drowned Saturday, August 4, at Port Limon, Costa Rica.

Dr. Shanks had been in Costa Rica since July 18 attending an Institute of Tropical Ecology at the University of Costa Rica. While on a field trip he went swimming and appeared to have a heart attack.
