NANTAHALA FINE ARTS SHOW IS SCHEDULED FOR THIS WEEKEND

The 1964 Nantahala Fine Arts Show will be held on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, August 7th, 8th, and 9th. The show, to be held in the old Highlander Restaurant (next to the Post Office), will be open for public viewing from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.

The Art Show is to benefit the Hudson Library and a small admission price of 50¢ (children under twelve years of age admitted free) per person will be charged.

Artists in and around a twenty-five mile radius of Highlands will enter works in the following categories: oil painting, watercolors, mixed media, graphics, sculpture, and ceramics.
