## LIVINGSTON AND JENNER TO LECTURE

Mr. John L. Livingston, Rice University, will lecture on the geology of the Highlands area on Friday, July 16, at 3:00 P. M. in the Museum Building. Mr. Livingston is in residence at the Biological Station studying the geology of the Blue Ridge escarpment.

On Friday evening, July 22, 8:00 P. M. in the Museum Building, Dr. Charles E. Jenner will lecture on photoperiodism or nature's 365 day week.

A photoperiod is the amount of daylight per day to which an organism is exposed. It has a marked influence on the time of flowering of plants, the time of migration of birds, the time of spawning of fish, and the seasonal change of color of certain birds and mammals.

Dr. Jenner is professor of zoology at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and a member of the board of trustees of the Highlands Biological Station.

The lectures are a part of the nature study program for adults sponsored by the Highlands Biological Station. Mr. C. H. Ekdahl has led one bird walk as a part of the program and will lead others during the summer. Watch for announcements.
