A painter by trade, Mr. Holt kept busy at his work until about three years ago when declining health forced him to retire. He was a native of Franklin but had made his home in Highlands for the past twenty-five years.

He is survived by one sister, Mrs. Simon Ivanoff of Tampa, Fla., and a halfbrother, E. P. Jarrett of Long Beach, Cal. He was a first cousin of Harry and Richard Holt and Mrs. Dewey Hopper, of Highlands, and an uncle of Mrs. Claude Zachary, also of Highlands.
