Construction of the new \$328,470. expansion wing to the Highlands-Cashiers Hospital is expected to get underway immediately. The ground breaking ceremony will be held at three o'clock Sunday (August 29) afternoon. Mr. Robert DuFree, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Hospital, will officiate.

The new expansion wing will be built by Smith and Jones Construction Company of Atlanta and Murphy, N. C. The Duke Endowment will assist in the difference of cost and money available. The public is invited to this important ceremony.
