SPECIAL SERVICES TO GET UNDERWAY BISHOP TO PREACH FIRST AT METHODIST CHURCH

The Reverend Earl G. Hunt, G.G.L.L.D. Bishop of the Episcopal Area of the Western North Carolina Annual Conference of the Methodist Church, will be the guest minister at the first service in a series of preaching services this summer, sponsored by the Inter-Church group of the churches of Highlands. This service of worship will be in the Highlands Methodist Church, Sunday, July 17th, at 8:00 p.m.

There will be a united choir, composed of members from the choirs of the participating churches, directed by Mrs. L. C. Pinnix.

Bishop Hunt was elected to the Episcopacy by the Southeastern Jurisdictional Conference of 1964. Prior to that, he was President of Emory and Henry College in Virginia for eight years.

He is a native of Tennessee, and was a member of the Holston Annual Conference in which he held several pastorates prior to his being a college president.
