Their first recording "Love Me Do" sold a respectable 100,000 copies. It was the last time a Beatle single sold less than half-million! Their first million seller, "She Loves Me" came out in the spring of 1963. Then came the unprecedented success, "I Want To Hold Your Hand", and there has been no stopping them since!

Beatle music is wild, pungent, hardhitting, uninhibited. . . and personal. Beatle popularity reached a pinnacle of sorts when the group headed the annual command performance for the Royal Family. The Queen Mother found them". . . young, fresh, and vital."
