

DEATH TAKES MRS. HARRELL

ADULT TYPING CLASSES

Adult Typing Classes will be offered in the Highlands area if there are enough persons interested in the course. This will be for persons 18 years and over; it will be beginning typing, and will last for 10 weeks, 2 nights per week, and 3 hours per night. There will be a charge of \$12.50 per person for the 10 week session.

This course is being offered by the Jackson Industrial Education Center, and students will be offered the same instructions as would be obtained at the Center, and, if students are later interested in enrolling in the Industrial Education Center as a student, the typing course would also count as credit.

The only requirement for obtaining

these classes in Highlands is that there must be twelve or fifteen students who want to take the beginning typing course. The date the classes will begin is determined by when the list of prospective students is received by the Center.
