This is the time of the year for lilies. Numerous varieties can be found in our prolific mountain area. Turk's-Caps (Iilium superbum linnaeus) not to be confused with Wichaus's Carolina tiger lily are in bloom along the roadside between Highlands and Cashiers. Lilies are springing up everywhere - even at the Country Emporium. Not to be confused with the original shifts of this name, these are cool, comfortable and $1 / 2$ the price. Please refruin from picking the lilium superbum linnaeus. But do pick out several cool, colorful, cotton shifts (superbum immitation Lilliums) at the
