

CITIZENS' MEETING

A meeting of approximately 250 of the townspeople of Highlands was held at the Highlands School Saturday night, June 6. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss with the Hospital Board the most effective way to persuade Dr. Pate to reconsider her resignation from the Highlands-Cashiers Hospital, and to clarify recent developments of the Medicare Program as it affects the local hospital.

A resolution was signed by those present requesting Dr. Pate to withdraw her resignation, and a meeting with the hospital board was scheduled for Tuesday, June 9. Results of this meeting were not available at the time of going to press.
