Answering questions from the floor, Mr. Guffey explained that the Bell system is prohibited by law from acquiring any independent companies. He stated that the estimate is that by 1980 there will be 700 independent companies serving 50,000,000 stations.

The possibility of providing toll free service between the Highlands and Cashiers exchanges was discussed. Mr. Guffey stated that the company could not suggest such a step, but if interested citizens would express a desire for this service through the State Utilities Commission at Raleigh some action might result. It was pointed out that the Highlands - Cashiers Hospital serves the area served by both the Highlands and the Cashiers exchanges and it would be a great convenience to have toll free service available. The area served by the Highlands Rotary Club also includes the southern half of Jackson County and several members reside in that area.
