Group's First Play: Illusion Or Reality?

Illusion or reality? This is the question that each of the six characters in Luigi Pirandello's "Six Characters In Search of an Author" attempts to answer.

The play is to be the first of the season for ACC's Stage and Script.

The father in the play is in his late forties, a pale man with hair thinning at the temples. He is dressed conservatively and generally appears either relaxed and quite charming, or rough and almost violent. He is the head of the group of characters who have come in search of a place to re-inact an episode of their unfortunate lives.

Small and weary, the mother appears in her early forties seemingly thoroughly defeated by life, as if she has been overwhelmed by some dreadful disgrace. She is dressed in the black of mourning which is a direct contrast to her chalk white, wax-like face. She is not in accord with the father's idea of presenting a portion of their story on stage, and bears a look of silent anguish and down-cast eyes.

The stepdaughter is very beautiful, dashing and impudent. Her greatest desire is the reliving of the story with particular attention paid to the near catastrophic seduction scene in Madame Pace's bedroom.

The boy is 14 — a frightened, dejected figure also dressed in mourning. He is held in contempt by the stepdaughter, whereas she displays the greatest tenderness and affection for the little girl. The little girl is about four years old and wears a

white dress with a black sash at the waist.

The son is 22, tall and severe in manner. He treats his father with resentment, and his mother with indifference. He is dressed properly and conservatively, but is clearly not in mourning.

Although not listed as one of the six characters, Madame Pace eventually appears with the family to take her part in the story. She is the owner of a dress shop, but also specializes in taking young ladies under her guidance in training to bring good cheer to her men customers. She is described as an ugly woman, wearing an incredible carrot-colored wig.

These six characters, along with Madame Pace, combine personalities and versions of the story in an attempt to prove to theirs is a play of the unreal. But what is it in truth: illusion or reality?

the ideas and issues presented. Therefore, compulsory attendance will be required for Convocations, and attendance for Conversations will be voluntary.

Penalty

In regard to the penalty to be imposed for failure to abide by compulsory attendance regulations, after the second unexcused absence in a semester a student will be warned concerning his relationship to the regulation, and after the third unexcused absence in a semester he will be placed on probation.

Upon the occurrence of the fourth unexcused absence the student will be removed from

the college after completing the semester's academic work for which he could receive credit.

With the elapse of one semester (summer sessions excluded), the student will be eligible to apply to the Admissions Committee for readmission.

Excused absences will be granted upon presentation of valid evidence of being involved in a legal or military obligation, a medical case, or a matter of death.

The matter of petitions for waiving the requirements for attendance at Convocations will be handled by the Petitions Committee.

Date Lists

A listing of the dates of the Convocations and an indication of the nature of the program will be given to each student at the beginning of the semester in order for him to be advised well in advance of the scheduled events and have opportunity to make plans for attendance.

The President will appoint a person responsible for the administration of this program, giving attention to the mechanical details of implementing the program such as scheduling, method of taking attendance, appeals procedure, etc.
