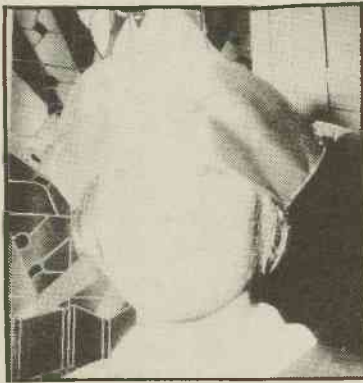
Graduating seniors are preparing for that big day, along with making plans for their futures.
