

Not Following Instructions

by being disobedient and unfaithful, creates many very dangerous hazards. These difficulties always arise when the employee does not carry out instructions to the best of his ability, which causes serious accidents, lost time and in some cases even death.

Some months ago, an employee received a very small scratch on his hand. He did not report for First Aid immediately after the injury. Several days la-

ter infection set in.
