

This scene is only mildly descriptive of the many beautiful and varied scenes that greet the eyes of the autoist on the New Blue Ridge Parkway, which is being rapidly pushed to completion. Here we have a view taken 8 miles directly East of Roaring Gap, looking towards Roaring Gap. This beautiful highway winds for many miles along the top of the Blue Ridge, cutting in behind peaks like the one shown, then bursting out on top, with endless miles of landscape laid out in crazy quilt patterns thousands of feet below. This road is not yet open to traffic, but one may see parts of it at different points along the route.
