

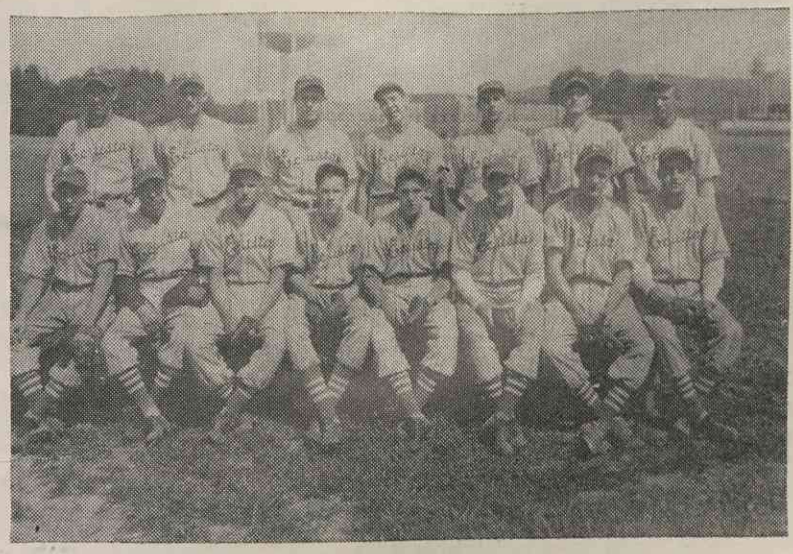
ECUSTA UNDEFEATED TENNIS CAMPAIGN
