
THINGS WE SHOULD

MOREEXPERT SAYS LAZY
WIFE MAY COST
HUSBAND LIFE

Wives can help the defense program by getting their husbands' breakfasts and being generally sympathetic, a safety expert declared today.

Home conditions were responsible for many industrial accidents that cost the defense program 41,912,000 man days of work last year, W. T. Cameron, safety advisor to the U. S. Labor Department, told the Ohio State Safety conference.

"Sometimes a man got careless because his wife got up too late to give him breakfast," Cameron said. "Many accidents were caused by lack of sleep, hangovers, intoxication, domestic quarrels, and financial worries directly due to home conditions.

"In times like these there is more money around, more drinking and night clubbing, which in turn leads to a careless and reckless feeling which causes accidents.

"It is up to women to be as sympathetic and as good an influence on their husbands now as possible."

Cameron said 18,000 persons were killed and 89,600 permanently injured in industrial accidents last year, "when the defense program couldn't afford to lose a single man."

Charles Lamb wrote: "The greatest pleasure I know is to do a good action by stealth and have it found out by accident."
