Following is the league standing at the close of the season, the pitching records and the batting averages of all participating players:

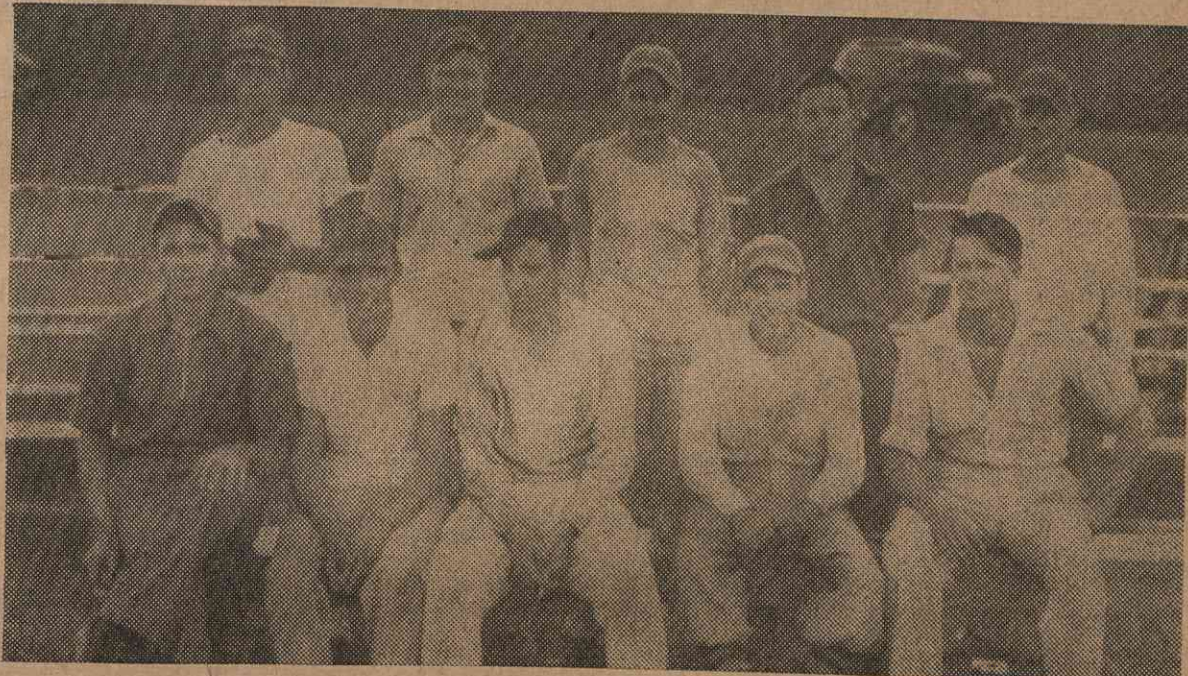
