

Hospital Savings Plan Available To Families

NEW EMPLOYEES HAVE 90 DAYS TO TAKE OFFER

Arrangements have been made with the Hospital Savings Association for new employees to enroll their families in the hospital savings plan at any time within 90 days after their employment begins.

This means that a new employee can immediately insure the members of his family without having to wait for representatives of the Hospital Saving Association to make their regular visits. This arrangement will be very convenient for the returning servicemen, who are already familiar with the plan and who want immediate coverage for their families. Those who do not elect to insure their families within 90 days after employment, will have to wait for the regular visit of the representative of the Hospital Saving Association.

During the first 15 days in December the Hospital Saving Association will accept enrollments from any employee of Ecusta, Champagne or Endless Belt. If the employees who have been here more than 90 days do not enroll their families during this two weeks period, they will have to wait until the next regular enrollment time which will be in June. Any employee who wants to include the dependent members of his family in this hospital and medical plan may do so by applying at the Personnel Office at any time during the first 15 days in December. Any new employee can include members of his family at any time within 90 days after employment. When the application is made, it is necessary to furnish the names and birth dates of all members of the family who are to be included.

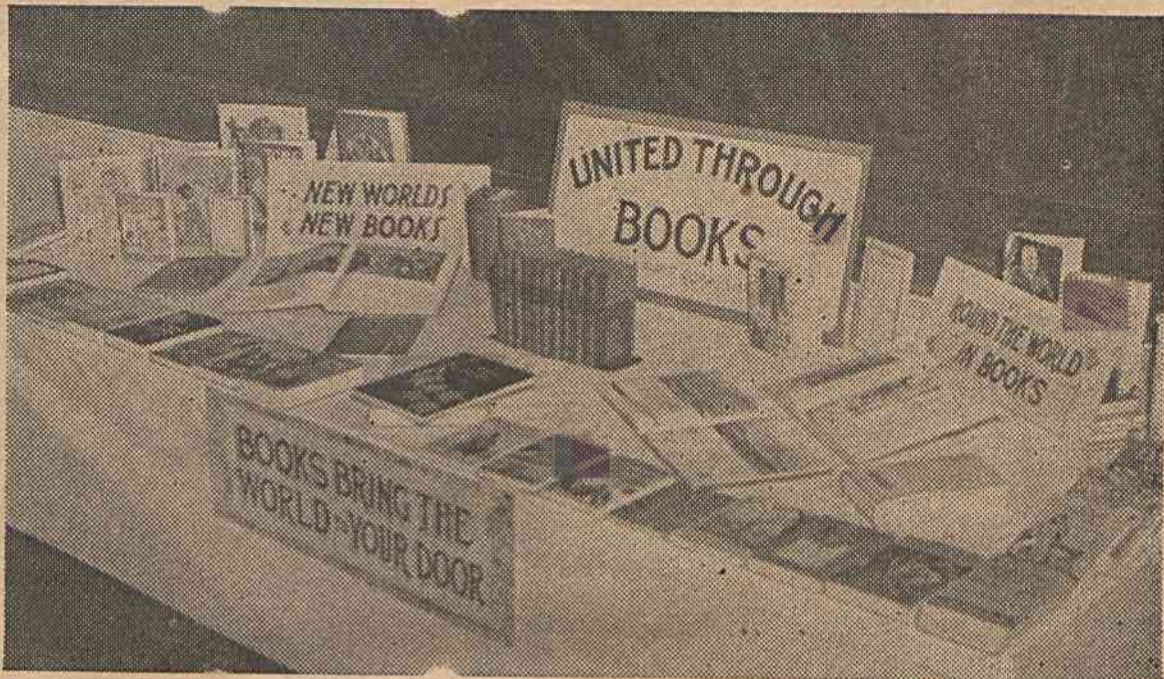

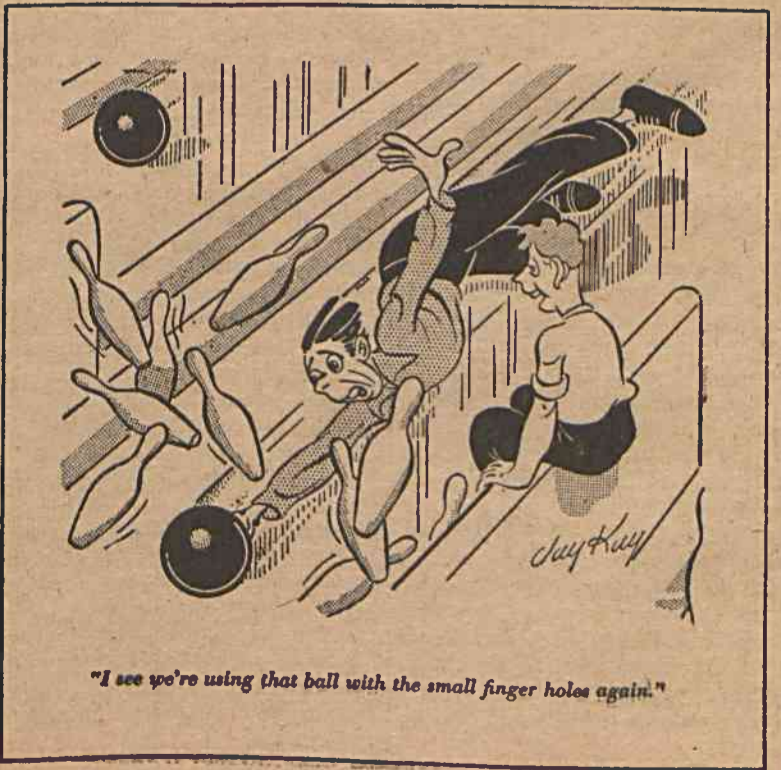
Ecusta Library Books On Display At PTA Meeting
