One senior expressed the opinion that she personally would rather go to a baseball game than a track meet. She also believes that baseball would be a better inducement in the recruiting of new students.
"Softball and baseball can be played at Weaver Park, less than a mile from campus, until a permanent field can be found on campus," says Reynolds. "I like baseball, but I cannot see why baseball should be added at the expense of tearing up an expensive installation that provides year-around sports activities.'
"It is the policy at UNCA that the athletic program be directed at life long sports. These are things you can use once you leave school," says Grams. "Running is an activity
