UNCA to Hold Holiday Ceramics and Art Sale December 6-7





The development of a greenway along Broadway's Glenn Creek and W.T. Weaver Boulevard, with traffic calming measures, fosters opportunities to walk and ride bikes, as well as a safer, more pleasant experience for motorists. This project contributes to better water quality in Glenn's Creek by effectively managing large quantities of storm water runoff from UNCA parking areas within the riparian buffer and the greenway.
