New Order displays disorderly thinking

They try to tell us, the people who write the letter appearing on this page under the "In Your Opinion" heading, that it is a myth that six million people died at the hands of the Nazis in WWII. They try to tell us that Hitler, the perpetrator of these murders, was a decent, even admirable human being. They try to persuade us that those of his henchmen who are still alive, and for whom Beate Klarsfeld and others are seeking just punishment, are nothing more than, as they claim in one of the flyers with which they've been blanketing our campus, "aging anti-Communist refugees who have never hurt anyone in this country."

Apparently they have never met a woman, a U.S. citizen, who tells, with tears in her eyes, of the children and husband she saw swallowed alive in the hellish maw of a death camp. Apparently they have never seen an American man roll up his sleeve to reveal the indelible numbers tattooed on his arm by some SS trooper forty plus years ago. Apparently they think concentration camp survivor Elie Wiesel was lying when he told President Reagan in a speech last Friday, "One million Jewish children have perished...I have seen them being thrown into the flames - alive!"

If this is not so, then it seems improbable that they could so vehemently gainsay the evidence of Nazi mass killings, and call those "witch hunters" who are seeking the murderers.

However, perhaps they could say this even if they have seen and do believe, for in reading their literature one is forced to conclude that these neo-Nazis believe that nearly every person who died in the concentration camps was a Communist spy or sympathizer and was thus "properly executed." One wonders how they explain why so many of those who died were children.

In addition, any group that blatantly states that "all men are NOT created equal," and that admits that even within the "superior" white race "science should work to eliminate hereditary weaknesses and defects," and to encourage "a high birthrate among those sections of the White population which are the healthiest, strongest and most intelligent," seems to hold in abeyance the sacredness of human life, reserving it only for those deemed fit to survive.

In their letter they call for a "spiritual awakening." One wonders of what spirit they speak. It could not be a Christian one, for the Bible says in Acts 17:24 and 26: "God that made the world and all things therein...hath made of one blood all nations of men, for to dwell on the face of the earth." According to this text, in following a course of racial isolation, members of the New Order are cutting themselves off from their own blood brothers and sisters of all races.
