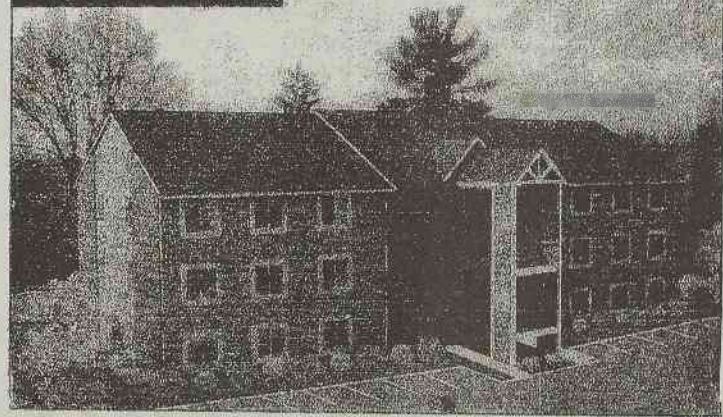

The amendment reads as follows: I-4700 (FS-0113A) - 126, I-40 to NC280, Buncombe County. Add additional lanes. Scheduled for planning and environmental studies only (Planning to be funded using Highway Trust Fund balance). Comments may be submitted in writing to Dan Baechtold, City of Asheville, P.O. Box 7148, Asheville, NC 28802, or by email to dandb@mail.ci.asheville.nc.us. Comments will be accepted until April 5, 2002. The amendment will be discussed at the regulatory scheduled meeting of the Transportation Advisory Committee to be held on April 18, 2002 at 12:10 p.m. in room A-109 of the Public Works Building at 161 South Charlotte St. The meeting is open to the public.


