With two girls on the campus chasing him, Claude H. really must have what it takes!

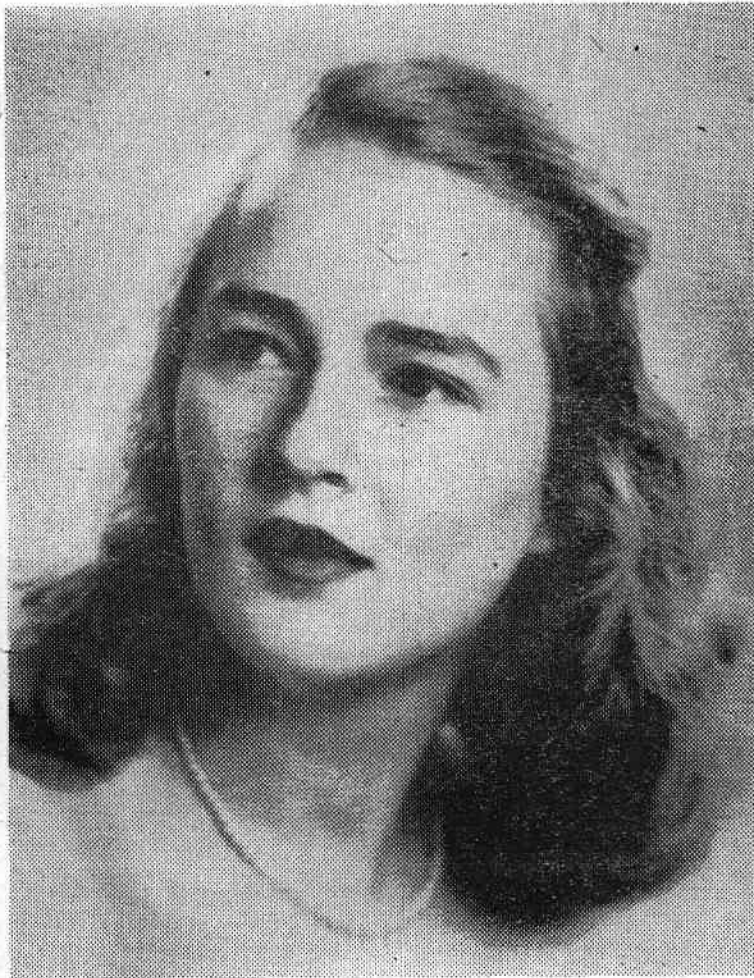
Eleanor Orr can't seem to make up her mind which one it's to be. Well, we don't blame you. Lander, Gary, and Bruce are all pretty swell guys.

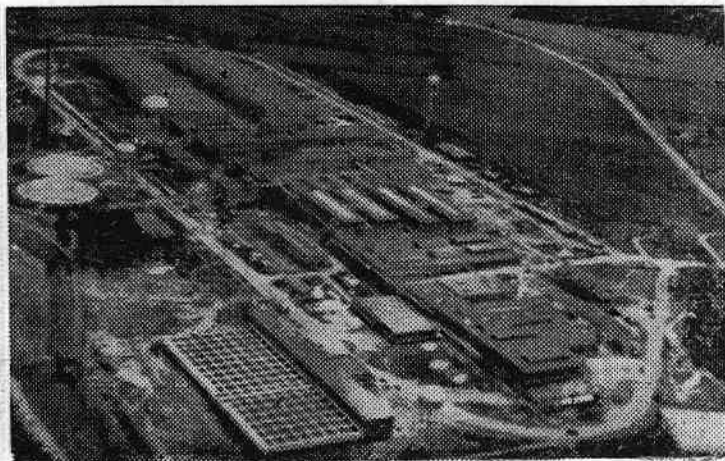
