Coach Bob Andrews' 1949 baseball team will blow the top off the forthcoming season this afternoon in Shelby when they take on the Bulldogs of Gardner-Webb in the first game of the year.

Harold "Fireball" Skipper or Albert Thomas will take the mound for the Tornadoes, depending on how the two shape up at game time. Providing he doesn't start the game, Thomas will be in left field, with LaNue Floyd and Lander Beal holding down the center and right field spots, respectively.

Starting in the infield will be John McKissick behind the plate, Ray DeLapp at first, Dick Medlin at second, Ernest "Beanie" Dickerson at shortstop, and Hershey Hipps at third.
