

# Euterps And Clios Plan Christmas Dance!

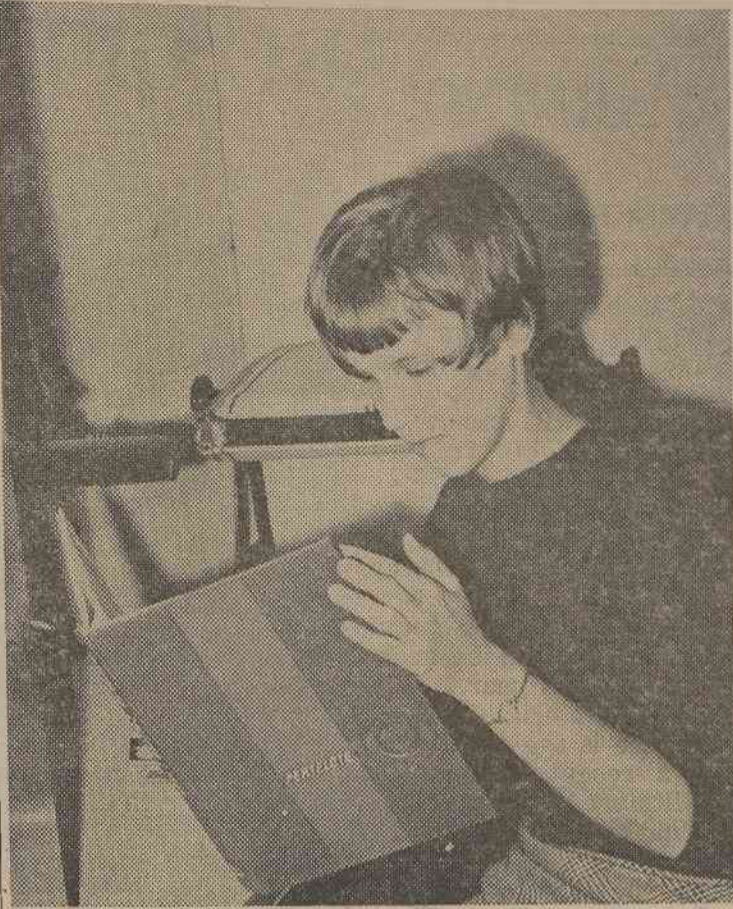

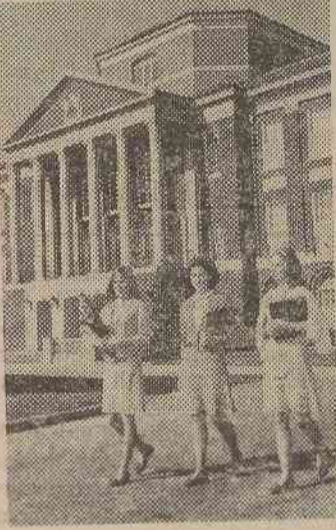

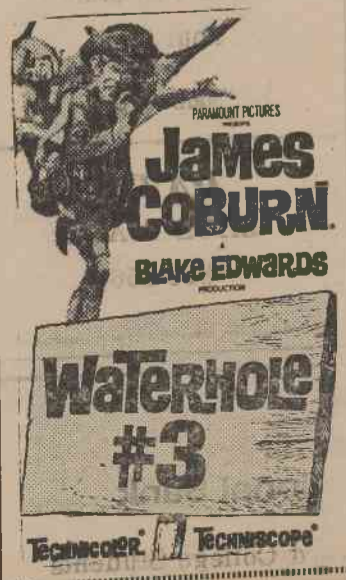
