Roadrunners Defeat Wingate In Last Home Meet

Although running with a diminished force, resulting from injuries, Brevard came through with another cross country victory over Wingate here Thursday in the team's last home stand of the season.

Setting the pace for the Road Runners of Brevard were Bob Gray, Jim Fussell, and Don Jones combining a 1-2-3 punch at the finish line to capture the first three places.

C. B. Stanley edged out Jimmy Thames for the fourth slot in a race that was apparently over the entire course. Stanly stove off Jim's determined last attack as the two came down the home stretch and eked out a fourth place position, moving Thames to 5th.

Sam Autrey and Mike Poole anchored the meet for the home team finishing 6th and 7th, well ahead of the pursuing Wingate pack.
