The team in previous play faced Spartanburg and received a heartbreaking loss of 307 Spartanburg and 308 Brevard. Tomorrow, Coach Hardin's men will again make a bid for a win over Spartanburg to tie in conference play. This match will be held at Glen Cannon Golf Course, and as this is an all important match, the team members and Coach Hardin invite the students and faculty to attend the match. "Brevard's original philosophy was to serve this part of the state, so we have made a concentrated effort to recruit in Western Carolina this year. I feel this will enhance the interest in Brevard's athletic program in the future.
