



## Internship

Internship Opportunities for ethnically diverse, disabled and female students in conservation, environmental and cultural resources organizations.

Requirements: Self-motivated and dedicated students GPA of 3.0 - currently enrolled in college Permanent Legal Resident or US Citizen Completed freshman year

**The Diversity Intern Program** - full range of careers available with the federal sector - weekly living allowance between \$390-\$510

**Cultural Resources Diversity Internship Program** - historical preservation and cultural/historical resource management weekly living allowance between \$390-\$510

**Rivers, Trails & Conservation Assistance Program** - hourly wage between \$7.85 and \$11.30

National Park Service Seasonal Referrals - hourly wage between \$7.85 and \$11.30

**Fellowship Program** - field-based careers within natural and cultural resources. Biweekly living allowance of \$100 transportation and housing assistance. Opportunity to earn an education award between \$1500-\$3000.
