Soccer and tennis teams announced, coaches tapped

Louisburg College sports fans will enjoy two additions to Hurricane scoreboards in the fall of '95: men's/ women's soccer and men's/women's tennis. The announcement was made last month and the search for players and coaches has begun.

A group of faculty and students have already selected Andrea Lane to coach the tennis teams. She is a graduate of Transylvania College in Lexington, Kentucky where she excelled in post-season play during each of her four seasons.
