
Haven't been to a coffeehouse lately? Maybe it is because we haven't had anyone to schedule a group.

Assistant Dean for Student Life Dawn Keller left Louisburg in February. A search committee is currently looking for a qualified person to fill Dean Keller's position. A Master's degree in Education and at least three years experience are required of anyone who will be hired. Recently, the committee sifted through 32 applicants, but only four have been chosen for further consideration. The committee has reopened the search.
